Dear Family and Friends,

The holidays offer a special time for celebration, reflection, and showing appreciation to the people and organizations that have made a difference in our lives. Faculty and staff of the Florida State University Autism Institute would like to thank you for allowing us to be a part of your family's life. Over the last 30 years, your participation and support have enabled us to conduct research and develop therapies that have dramatically improved communication, social, and cognitive skills in children and adults with autism spectrum disorder (ASD).

To date, our **research funding** has come from federal agencies including the *U.S. Department of Education*, the *National Institutes of Health*, the *Centers for Disease Control and Prevention*, and *Autism Speaks*. The Florida State Legislature has provided the funding for the *Center for Autism and Related Disabilities* (CARD) for services to clients from infants to adults with ASD. Sadly, these funding sources have declined, leaving a pressing need for new financial support, additional staff and new volunteers.



As a CARD client, you are familiar with some of what we do. Eight years ago, the Institute was established in the College of Medicine to bridge the gap between science and practice. Research, community outreach, therapy, and referrals are some of the ways the Autism Institute addresses these growing needs. A *sampling of the free services* and current research projects provided by the FSU Autism Institute include:

- Free Screening and Early Diagnosis of autism and other communication disorders (*FIRST WORDS*[®] *Project*)
- Early Intervention Research (*Early Social Interaction Project*)
- School-Age Intervention Research (Classroom SCERTS Intervention Project)
- Job Interview Training and Social Skills for Teens & Adults (*Social-Pragmatic Treatment*)
 Web-based Tools (*ASD Video Glossary*, *Autism Navigator*[®])
