This interactive web-based course is comprised of hundreds of videos showing evidence-based intervention techniques that you can use in everyday activities to support your child's learning. This interactive program will teach you how to embed strategies and supports into your everyday activities, provide developmental growth charts to help you recognize and monitor meaningful outcomes, and offer a video library to illustrate how to promote learning and development for young children with autism spectrum disorder (ASD).
