## Sensorimotor Abnormalities and Their Neural Mechanisms in Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD)

The Neurocognitive and Behavioral Development lab (NBD-lab) currently is seeking individuals with and without Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD) for participation in a clinical research study. This study aims to better understand the wide range of symptoms that are present in this disorder and determine their brain bases.

Eligible individuals will be asked to complete the following **non-invasive** tests:

- Questions about medical, developmental and family history
- Autism diagnostic evaluation
- Puzzles, games
- Tests of fine motor performance
- Tests of gross motor coordination
- Tests of brain anatomy and function

### Locations

Testing will be conducted at UF (Gainesville campus) and UF McKnight Brain Institute. All procedures have been approved by our local Institutional Review Board.

- Between the ages of 35 to 75 years
- Received a diagnosis of Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD)
