FSU CARD offers adult clients and family members short-term consultation and training related to autism spectrum disorder (ASD).

Services Available

Services are tailored to each client's needs, which may include support(s) in the workplace, school, home, and community.

Individual:

- Education, support, and guidance are provided about how ASD may affect individuals
- Strategies to address concerns at work, school, home, and community
- Assistance with locating community resources, such as medical professionals, support groups, and social service agencies

Workplace:

- Guidance and strategies to assist clients experiencing challenges in workplace
- At client's request, provide feedback and support to employers and job coaches
- Develop visual supports and other accommodations needed for success in the workplace

Post-Secondary:

- Guidance and strategies to assist clients experiencing challenges in academic or vocational settings
- Provide feedback and support to administrators and academic staff

Social Skills Groups:

- Quarterly meetings, one hour per session
- Various topics discussed utilizing games, presentations, guest speakers, question/answer sessions
